

**MINUTES OF THE  
NATIONAL FASTPITCH COACHES ASSOCIATION  
ASSISTANT COACHES CAUCUS**

*November 28, 2007*

*Hilton Hotel, Las Vegas, Nevada*

The meeting was brought to order at 3:05 p.m. by the Assistant Coach Representative Bill Gray, associate head coach at Kennesaw State University. NFCA Associate Executive Director Karen Johns staffed the meeting.

1. Welcome. Mr. Gray welcomed the group.
2. Reports.
  - A. Linda Wells, NFCA Hall of Fame Member - addressed the assistant coaches to kick off the NFCA's annual plan to have a different Hall of Fame member speak to the assistant coaches about the profession and some important advice that they would give to them.
